



### **KG2 – ORIGAMI ACTIVITY – 4<sup>th</sup> June 2021**

The first group activity for this academic session 2021-22 was the origami activity for KG2 kids held on 4<sup>th</sup> June 2021. Children participated in this creative venture with great zeal & high spirits. The tiny tots were amazed to see the transformation of a flat square paper into a house through folding. As the teacher demonstrated, children watched closely and listened carefully to the specific instructions and then followed it with neatness and accuracy. The paper folding craft was not only a fun-filled experience, but it also proved to be a valuable means to develop artistic skills in the young ones.







### KG1 – PALM PRINTING ACTIVITY – 4<sup>th</sup> June 2021

Children joined back this academic year on 2nd June with the initial onboarding sessions and then on 4th of June 2021, Our KG 1 blooms had their first Friday Circle time where they met with all their friends for the very first time with lots of enthusiasm. The session started with thanking God followed by a circle time song and meeting their friends for the first time. They thoroughly enjoyed the whole story of an enormous carrot which was wholeheartedly narrated by the teachers with lots of action and expression. This was not the end; our blooms had their first palm printing activity on an A4 sheet paper where they drew their family emojis on the finger of the palm.







### **KG2 – SENSE ORGAN ACTIVITY – 11<sup>th</sup> June 2021**

Children learn by doing than any other way. Hands on experinece gives them an opportunity for concrete learning of concepts. Focusing on the topic “parts of the body”an informative and ingenious science activity about the 5 sense organs was organised for the young minds who are naturally curious about the world around them. Kids followed the instructions given by the teacher and explored all the things which were kept ready for the activity. Kids understood about the 5 Sense organs and their uses in a fun & practical way. They had lot of fun tasting the salt, sugar and by making sound using the bowl and spoon.







### NURSERY FAMILY TREE ACTIVITY – 18<sup>th</sup> June

We say that our palms are palettes and our fingers paintbrushes! To create a Family Tree and to strengthen the fingers which helps with fine motor skills, Finger dabbing activity was held on 18th June 2021 for our tiny tots of Nursery. They had a picture of a tree with only the trunk which they coloured following which they dipped their fingers in the paint and created the leaves. Then they stuck photos of their family members on the tree. Our toddlers enjoyed the activity thoroughly. They were happy and thrilled to see their family members as part of a tree!

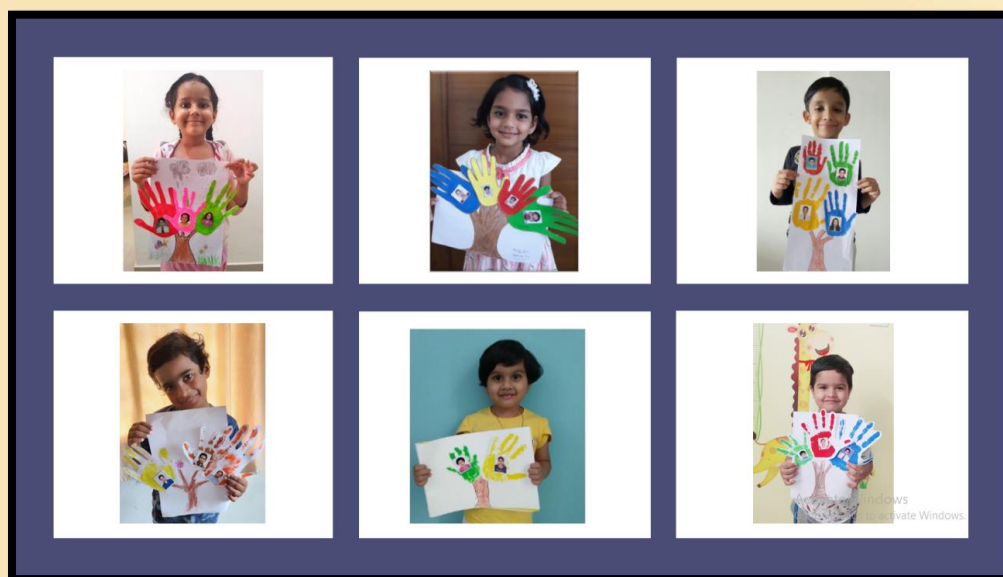


### **KG2 – FAMILY TREE HAND PRINTING ACTIVITY – 18th June**

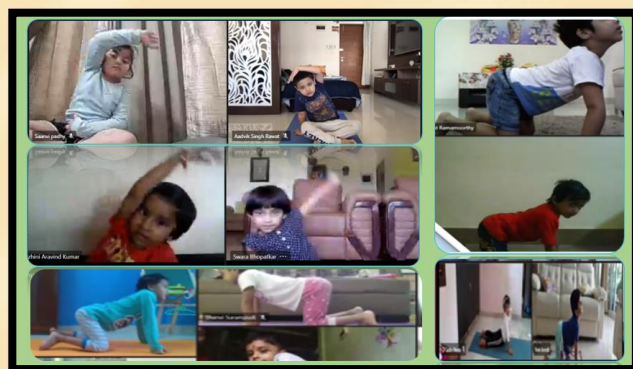




### KG2 & KG1 - INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY - 21<sup>ST</sup> June

On the last day of activity the kids were happily holding their pot with a full grown plant. They were so excited and happy to share their whole experience and observation.







## KG2 - SEED GERMINATION ACTIVITY – 5<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup> JULY '21

This activity ended on 16<sup>th</sup> July when the seeds had sporouted into tiny saplings. Kids were excited and proud to show the plants and share their experiences with the teachers.

Shape collage activity was planned for Nursery kids on 16th of July 2021.

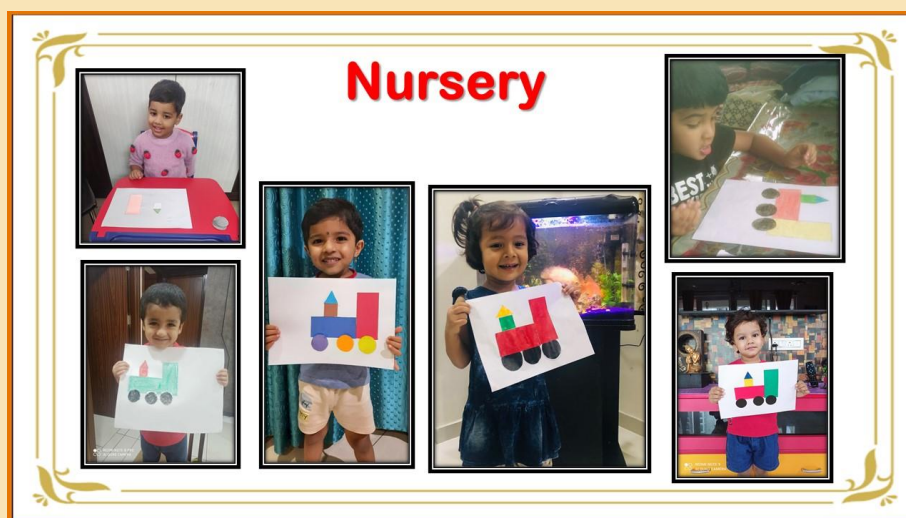
Creating a collage helps the children to build their fine motor skills. It was also a fun and interesting way to encourage the child's awareness of the concept of colours & shapes taught to them.

This gave the children an opportunity to identify the particular shape. Every time picking up the shape to stick on the collage was also boosting their confidence and the finished product at hand gave them immense pleasure.

This activity was a great success with lot of learning





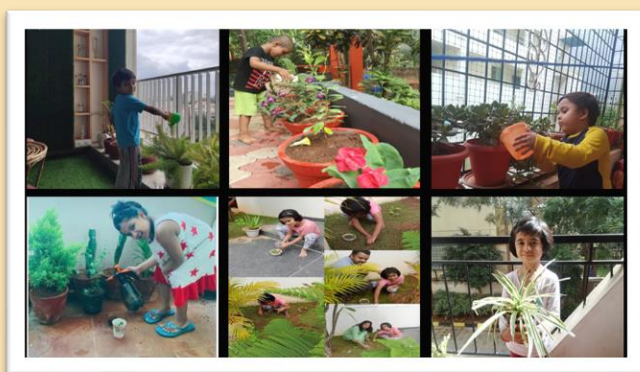


### WEEKEND BALCONY ACTIVITY – 18<sup>th</sup> JULY '21

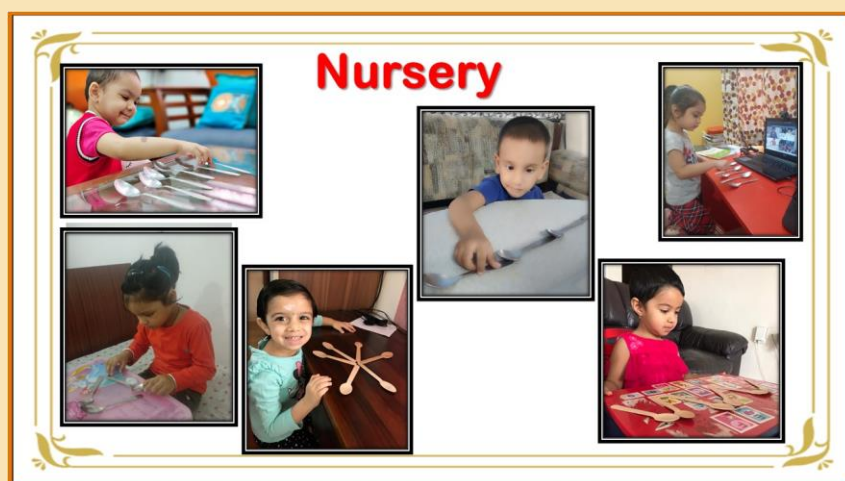






### NURSERY SPOONS PATTERN MAKING – 26<sup>th</sup> JULY 2021

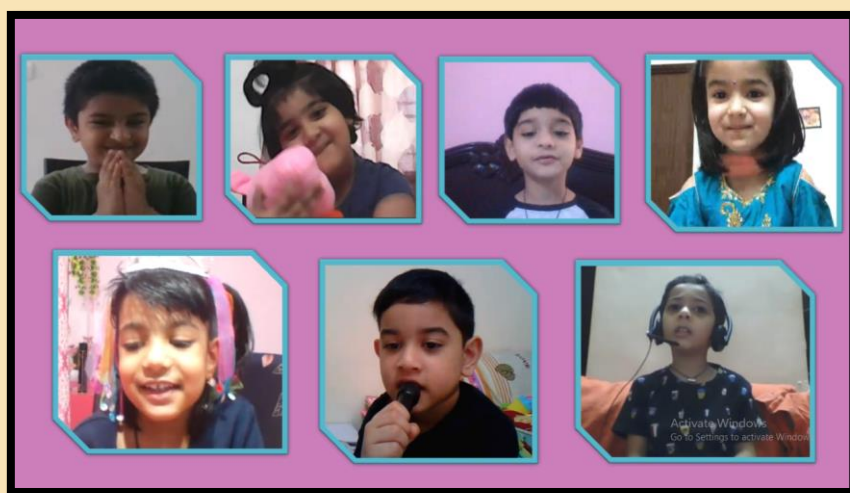

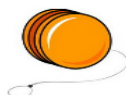

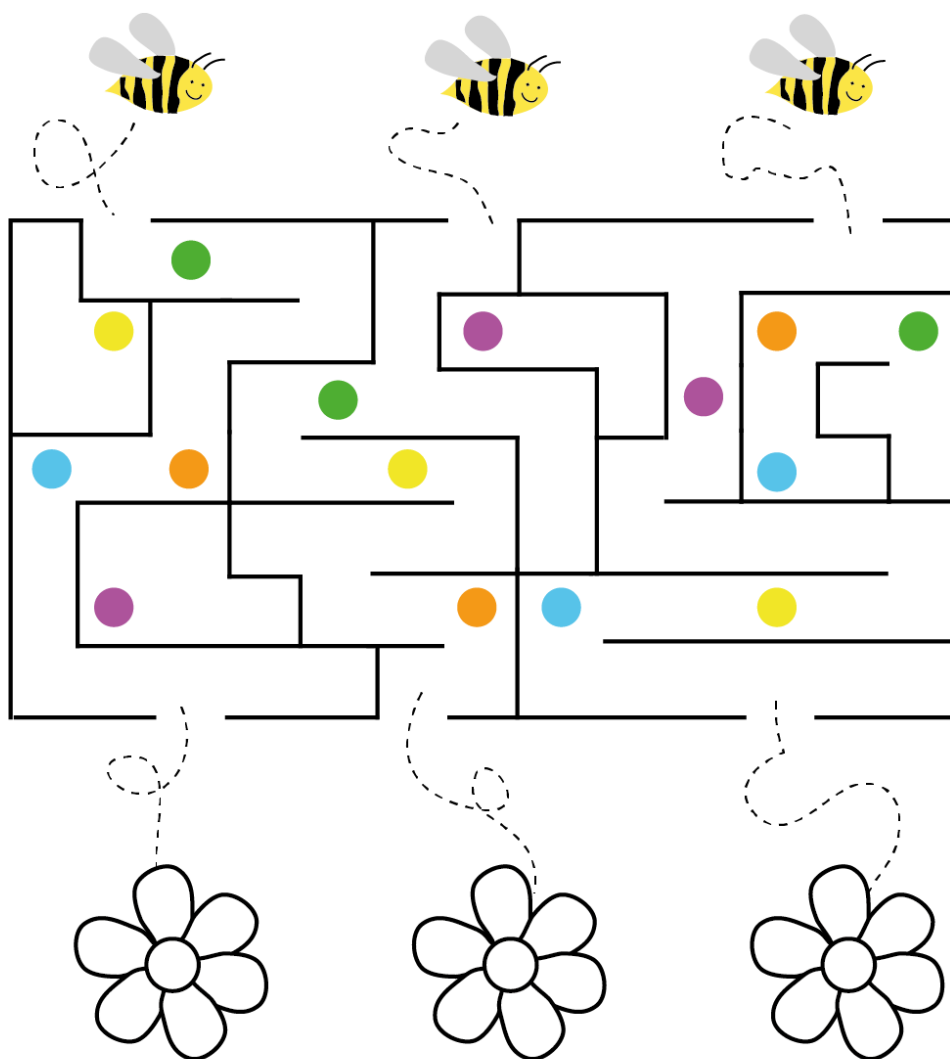
