



Activity-based learning always encourages toddlers to learn much better. Hence, our GT children enjoyed learning about sense organs with hands-on experience.

Teachers brought a few things like bowls of salt and sugar, perfume bottles and garlic, soft and hard toys, and a bowl with a spoon or bell. The activity focused on the functions and importance of the five senses in our body—sight, smell, hearing, taste, and feel.

Children got a hands-on experience by tasting sugar/salt; smelling perfume/garlic; hearing the bell sound; by touching and feeling the hard/soft toy; and by seeing all the different tactile materials kept on the table. The activity kept the children involved till the end, as each child had a great time performing the task related to each sense.







